Allah; therefore, recite however much of the Qur'aan is easy for you, and keep Salah established and give Zakah, and lend a good loan to Allah; whatever good you will send ahead for yourselves, you will find it with Allah, better and of great reward; and seek forgiveness from Allah; indeed, Allah is the Most Forgiving, the Most Merciful.
