(This Surah is Madani, containing 13 verses and 2 sections)

Allah's Name to commence with, the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful.

O believers! Do not 60:1. befriend My enemies and your enemies, you inform them (about your secrets) out of friendship; whereas, they deny that truth which has come to you. It is they who separate the Messenger and you from your homes on this basis that you believed in your Lord Allah. If you have come out to fight in My path and to gain My contentment, so do not befriend them. You send them secret messages of friendship, and I know well what you hide and you disclose. what And whoever amongst you does this, he has indeed gone astray from the straight path.

60:2. If they find you, so they will be your (open) enemies and will extend their hands and their tongues towards you with evil, and their wish is that

60:3. Neither your relations nor your offspring (left behind in Makkah because of whose safety, you keep friendship with the disbelievers) will ever benefit you, on the Day of Judgement. (Allah) will separate you from them; and Allah is seeing your deeds.

60:4. Indeed, there was a good example for you to follow in Ibrahim and those with him, when they said to their people 'Indeed, we are disgusted with you and what you worship other than Allah. We have rejected you, and enmity and hatred has surfaced between us and you forever until you accept faith in the One Allah.' Except for the saying of Ibrahim to his (figurative) father, 'I will definitely seek forgiveness for you. And I do not possess any power to benefit you against Allah.' (Ibrahim and followers said) 'O our Lord, we have relied upon only You, and only towards You we have turned and only towards You is the (final) return.'

60:5. 'O our Lord, do not make us a trial for the disbelievers (by making them dominant over

60:6. Indeed, in them was a good example for you to follow, (especially) for the one who is hopeful of (meeting) Allah and the Last Day; and whoever turns away (by befriending the disbelievers), so indeed only Allah is the Independent, the Most Praiseworthy.

60:7. It is near that Allah may create friendship between you and those amongst them who are your enemies (by making them Muslims); and Allah is All-Powerful; and Allah is Most Forgiving, Ever Merciful.

60:8. Allah does not forbid you from those who did not fight against you on account of (your) religion and (they) did not drive you out from your homes, that you may be favourable towards them and deal with them fairly; indeed, the just ones are the beloveds of Allah.

60:9. Allah forbids you to befriend those who fought

When Muslim women leave the land of disbelief and migrate towards you, so examine them (by taking an oath from them); Allah knows more about their faith; so if you find the women to be believers, do not therefore send them back to the disbelievers; neither are they (i.e. the believing women) lawful for the disbelieving (men), nor are the disbelieving (men) lawful (i.e. the believing for them women); and give back to their disbelieving husbands what they had spent (on these believing women e.g. dowry); and there is no sin upon you to marry them these believing women) (i.e. when you give them their dowry; and (O Muslims) do not continue the marriage with disbelieving women, and ask back (from the disbelievers) what you had spent, and the disbelievers may ask for what they had spent (on the believing women); this is Allah's command, He judges between you, and Allah is All Knowing, the Wise.

Whom you believe.

60:12. (Beloved) Prophet! Muslim women When present in your august court to pledge an oath of allegiance upon this fact that they will neither ascribe any partner to Allah, nor steal, nor commit adultery, nor kill their offspring, nor bring the fabrication that they carry between their hands and feet i.e. in their womb, nor disobey you in any righteous matter, so accept their allegiance and seek forgiveness from Allah for them; indeed, Allah is the Most Forgiving, the Most Merciful.

60:13. O believers! Do not befriend the people upon whom is the wrath of Allah; they have lost hope in the Hereafter just
