Allah's Name to commence with, the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful.

65:1. O (Beloved) Prophet! (Tell the believers) when you people divorce women, so divorce them (when they are in the state of purity, with one divorce) at (the start of) their prescribed period, and keep (an accurate) calculation of their 'Iddah (i.e. waiting period). And (O Muslims) fear Allah, your Lord, Do not banish them from their (husband's) homes, nor should they leave themselves during the 'Iddah period unless this that they commit any open indecency (i.e. fornication, or theft, etc.). And these are the limits of Allah; and

whoever transgresses the limits of Allah, indeed he has done wrong to himself. You do not know, maybe Allah will send a new command afterwards (so that you may take her back if that was the first or second divorce).

65:2. Hence, when they are about to reach their appointed term (nearing completion of 'Iddah), so hold them back with kindness or separate from them with kindness, and make two credible men amongst you as witnesses, and establish testimony for the sake of Allah; whosoever believes in Allah and the Last Day, he is advised with this; and whosoever fears Allah, Allah will create for him a way of salvation.

who have not yet had menstruation; and the appointed period for the pregnant women is this that they deliver their burden (i.e. give birth). And whoever fears Allah, Allah will create ease for him in his matters.

65:5. This is Allah's command which He has sent down towards you; and whosoever fears Allah, Allah will erase his sins and bestow upon him great reward.
